**ABSTRACT**

*The purpose of this Resolution, if approved by the voters, is to change the term of office of Town Supervisor in the Town of DeRuyter from two (2) years to four (4) years. The effect of this Resolution would be that the two (2) year term of office for the position of Town Supervisor in the Town of DeRuyter would terminate on January 1, 2027. Thereafter, for persons elected to the position of Town Supervisor in the Town of DeRuyter and taking office on and after January 1, 2027 will have a term of office of four (4) years.*
